Life in the Spirit Seminar Opportunities

➤ **Director**

The Director is responsible – with the help of the Seminar Team and Task Force – for all the practical aspects of setting up and running the Life In the Spirit Seminar. The Director’s amount of involvement with the specific details of the Seminar will vary by the size of the Seminar and the need for hands-on involvement versus delegation of duties.

Qualifications: A spiritually mature Christian who has a heart for the spiritual growth of seekers and believers; understands and agrees with the philosophy and theology of St. Stephen’s ministry; sees the Life in the Spirit Seminar as an ongoing ministry, not a onetime event; and possesses gifts in the area of leadership, administration and helps.

➤ **Small Group Coordinator**

The key responsibility of this person is to recruit, oversee, and encourage Small-Group Leaders and Helpers.

Qualifications: Experienced in facilitating small group interaction; organized; able to motivate and encourage others; understands that the purpose of small groups during the Seminar is to provide a safe place for seekers and believers to interact and respond to the talks; has good interpersonal skills, sensitive, gifted in areas of communication and mentoring; and has a servant’s heart.

➤ **Small Group Leaders**

The key responsibility of the Small Group Leader is to facilitate discussion in the small groups and to create a welcoming atmosphere where guests feel free to ask honest questions.

Qualifications: A growing Christian; sees the potential for spiritual growth in seekers and believers; is good with people; sensitive; understands the work of the Holy Spirit; is “full of the Spirit and wisdom” (Acts 6:3); understands how Christians grow in the Spirit; nonjudgmental; and has a servant’s heart.

➤ **Small Group Helpers**

The key responsibility of the Small Group Helpers is to assist the Small Group Leaders create a welcoming atmosphere where guests feel free to ask honest questions.

Qualifications: A growing Christian; is good with people; sensitive; understands from where seekers and believers are coming; nonjudgmental; and has a servant’s heart.

➤ **Task Force Coordinator**

The key responsibility of this person is to select and train the Seminar Task Force – a team of people who provide practical services for the Seminar involving everything from helping with registration to cleanup.

Qualifications: A mature or growing Christian; experienced in overseeing and delegating responsibility to others; organized; able to train others; understands

the need to provide a safe and comfortable environment where seekers and believers feel welcome; has good interpersonal skills; sensitive; gifted in areas of administration and help; and has a servant's heart.

➤ **Task Force Members**

The Task Force is to provide practical services for all aspects of the Life in the Spirit Seminar.

Qualifications: A growing Christian; is good with people; moving toward being "full of the Spirit in wisdom" (Acts 6:4); has beginning of gifts in the areas of helps and mercy; and has a servant's heart.

➤ **Book Table Coordinator**

The key responsibility of this person is to order and maintain a stock of Seminar resources and related reading.

Qualifications: A mature or growing Christian; experienced in overseeing and delegating responsibility to others; organized; has good interpersonal skills; gifted in areas of administration and help; and has a servant's heart.

➤ **Treasurer**

This person is responsible for handling all Seminar-related budgets and finances.

Qualifications: Experienced at keeping track of financial matters; reliable; honest; prompt; and has a servant's heart.

➤ **Worship Coordinator**

This person oversees all aspects of worship times during the Life in the Spirit Seminar.

Qualifications: Competent musician and song leader; responsible; has understanding of philosophy of worship during Seminar; is versatile with music that appeals both to unchurched and growing Christian; has positive, teachable attitude; demonstrates mature Christian character; and has a servant's heart.

➤ **Follow-Up Coordinator**

This person is responsible for overseeing and facilitating follow-up opportunities and needs after the Life in the Spirit Seminar.

Qualifications: A spiritually mature Christian who has a heart for the spiritual growth of seekers and believers; organized; able to motivate and encourage others; willing to reach out to others; sensitive; nonjudgmental; a good listener; able to keep track of details.
